Additional Fees:

Registration is \$50 for new students, Kindergarten, Grade 1 and Secondary I.

Affordability

CAPS – Hebrew Academy proudly participates in CAPS, a program of Federation CJA’s Generations Fund that subsidizes and freezes tuition based on household income and number of children enrolled in participating Jewish day schools.
